

"ARTIST'S CONCEPTION"

The above artist's conception is of the facial features of a body found in the Gulf near the sand beach, South of Moody's Motel, on Saturday, 16 June, 1979. The body is that of a W/M, early or late 20s, height approximately 5'10", weight 130-150 lbs., complexion light, color of eyes unknown. Hair is dark red worn long. No scars, no tattoos, or birthmarks could be found. Subject has all of his teeth with no dental work. Subject was wearing a shirt, make Elderado, size 20, short sleeve, color light brown, neck size 14-14½. Pants, make unknown, color red, white, and blue stripes (stripes run up and down), size 33 x 29. Belt, black leather with metal buckle. Shoes, make Xell (last part of wording can not be read), color light brown, size 6, type low quarters tie up earth shoes, rubber soles. Undershirt, make Fruit of the Loom, color white, size 14, type t-shirt. Underpants, make Fruit of the Loom, color white, size 32-34, type jockey shorts. Socks, white, athletic. Wallet had no contents. Watch, Timex, with numerals and calendar. Band is of leather alligator type. Watch had stopped at 12:05 P. M. on the 14th. No other jewelry was on the subject.

The subject appeared to have drowned. No foul play is suspected at this time.
